VILLAGE SPORT **CO-ORDINATORS**



The West Norfolk Sports Council wishes to appoint Village Sport Co-ordinators across the Borough. These posts will be voluntary but an 'honarium'/expense payment of up to £300 is available. Appointed co-ordinators will encourage the development of sport in their village/rural area, a role that may include some of the following activities:

- inspire an entry into the West Norfolk Inter Village Games;
- co-ordinate a loan of equipment scheme into the village to start up a new activity;
- form an organising group to receive external grants for village sporting projects;
- form an organising group to arrange coaching courses and activities for young people and/or other village residents;
- act as a focal point for sporting information in the village;
- act as a 'Champion for Sport' for the village, liaising with village organisations including Parish Councils, Village Halls and Playing Field Committees;
- co-ordinate a transport scheme to a sporting facility/activity;
- co-ordinate a Village Come-and-Try or Activity Day to encourage more people to take part in sport.

Would you like to become a Village Sport Co-ordinator? Don't be discouraged by this long list of tasks - you would agree to take on **some** of them, not all of them. You may choose to organise something yourself but you may also be an 'enabler' - someone who motivates and arranges others to organise. And if you are performing some of these responsibilities already it will not prevent you coming forward; you may simply be expected to undertake one or two other tasks too.
