Fenland Green Power Co-op will be the first of its kind in East Anglia.

The new Co-op will purchase two of the 2 Megawatt Repower wind turbines commissioned this summer at Deeping St. Nicholas. These two turbines can provide enough 'green' electricity for 2,000 homes.

The Fens Co-op is modelled on the highly successful Baywind Energy Co-op in Cumbria, which has operated profitably since 1996.

The launch of the co-op is organised and managed by Energy4All, a company set up by the Baywind Co-op and dedicated to helping communities own a share in renewable energy projects. Energy4All has its offices in Cumbria and this is where the administration of the Fens Co-op will take place.

The Share offer will be approved by the Financial Services Authority before launch. Shares will be available to everyone, with priority given to local people.

The minimum investment will be £250 and the maximum will be £20,000. Each member receives a single vote, regardless of how many shares they hold.

The co-op will work on normal co-operative principles with a Board elected by the members.

The co-op may also decide to support local energy and environmental initiatives, as has been done at Baywind.
